Cereal/Pulses/Oilseed Crops : -

- ❖ Harvested crop should be properly neat & clean and dry up to 10-12% of moisture content.
- ❖ Harvesting of wheat crop through combine harvester and preparation of wheat straw through straw reaper.
- ❖ Harvesting of Chickpea may be done through manual labour after ensuring the isolation distance issued by ICMR.
- ❖ Mass working should be avoided any agricultural practices.
- ❖ Ensure rotavating after harvesting of wheat crop to avoid fire in field.
- ❖ Crops sown for seed production should be harvest separately after drying and cleaning then store properly.
- ❖ Ensure the sowing of Green gram up to Ist week of April with the follow of recommended practices.

Vegetable Crops : -

- ❖ Ensure harvesting of garlic crop and store properly.
- ❖ Apply Irrigation in Onion, Brinjal, Tomato, Chilli, Cole crops and other vegetables at 10-12 days interval.
- ❖ Harvesting, Packaging, Transportation of vegetables in proper manner (bearing gloves & mask).
- ❖ Apply plant protection measures as per advisory issued by the Krishi Vigyan Kendra and keeping in regular touch with KVK Scientists.

Fruit Crops : -

- ❖ Ensure irrigation in Mango orchard and apply manure & fertilizer as per recommended dose.
- ❖ Training and pruning of Guava orchard.
- ❖ Ensure Bordeaux Pasting in fruit plants.
- ❖ Use of fruit fly traps @10 No. per ha. in Mango orchard.

- ❖ In citrus crops spray of Blitox -50 @2.5 ml./lit water to avoid citrus canker.

Animals : -

- ❖ Covid -19 is not a zoonotic disease i.e. not transmit from animal to human.
- ❖ Vaccinate animals against Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD).
- ❖ Ensure sowing of green fodder crops like maize & Bajara.
- ❖ Prevent Animals from heat stress.
- ❖ Keep animals shaded places, provides ample clean and fresh drinking water.

Poultry : -

- ❖ Avoid introduction of new flock and try to sale existing flock after maintaining proper and sanitary measures.
- ❖ As and when the condition become normal the rearing of of birds can be started as usual.
